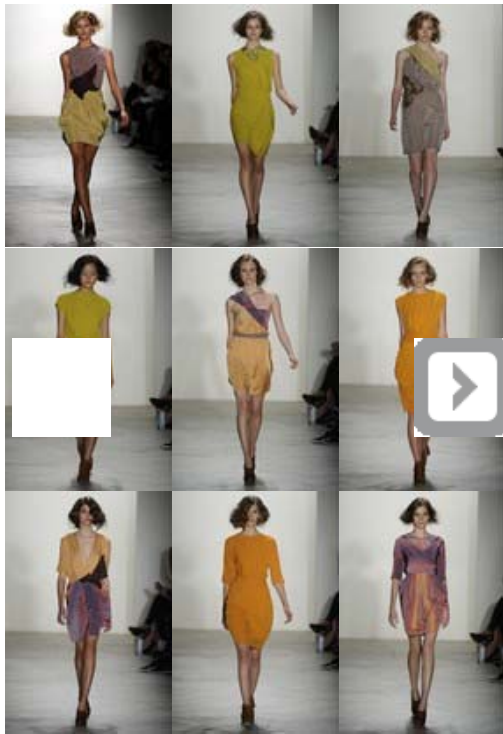


SPRING READY-TO-WEAR 2010
